

# Halvergate Mills Trail

12 km / 7.5 miles. Allow 3-4 hours.



WATER, MILLS

This challenging 7.5 mile trail encircles the iconic marshes of Halvergate and will take you along farm tracks, river banks and pass over a myriad of ditches and dykes.

Passing by numerous mills including Mutton's, High's, Howard's, Lockgate, Berney Arms, Stone's Mill and seeing many more in the wider

landscape is what makes this area so unique.

Spot a variety of marshland inhabitants on your journey from grazing Cows to darting Dragonflies to leaping Hares to soaring Marsh Harriers, every turn has a surprise in store.

On this walk, there is a stile, kissing gates, field gates and areas of uneven ground but the majority of the walk is flat.

The walk also passes two train crossings so take extra care and follow crossing instructions.

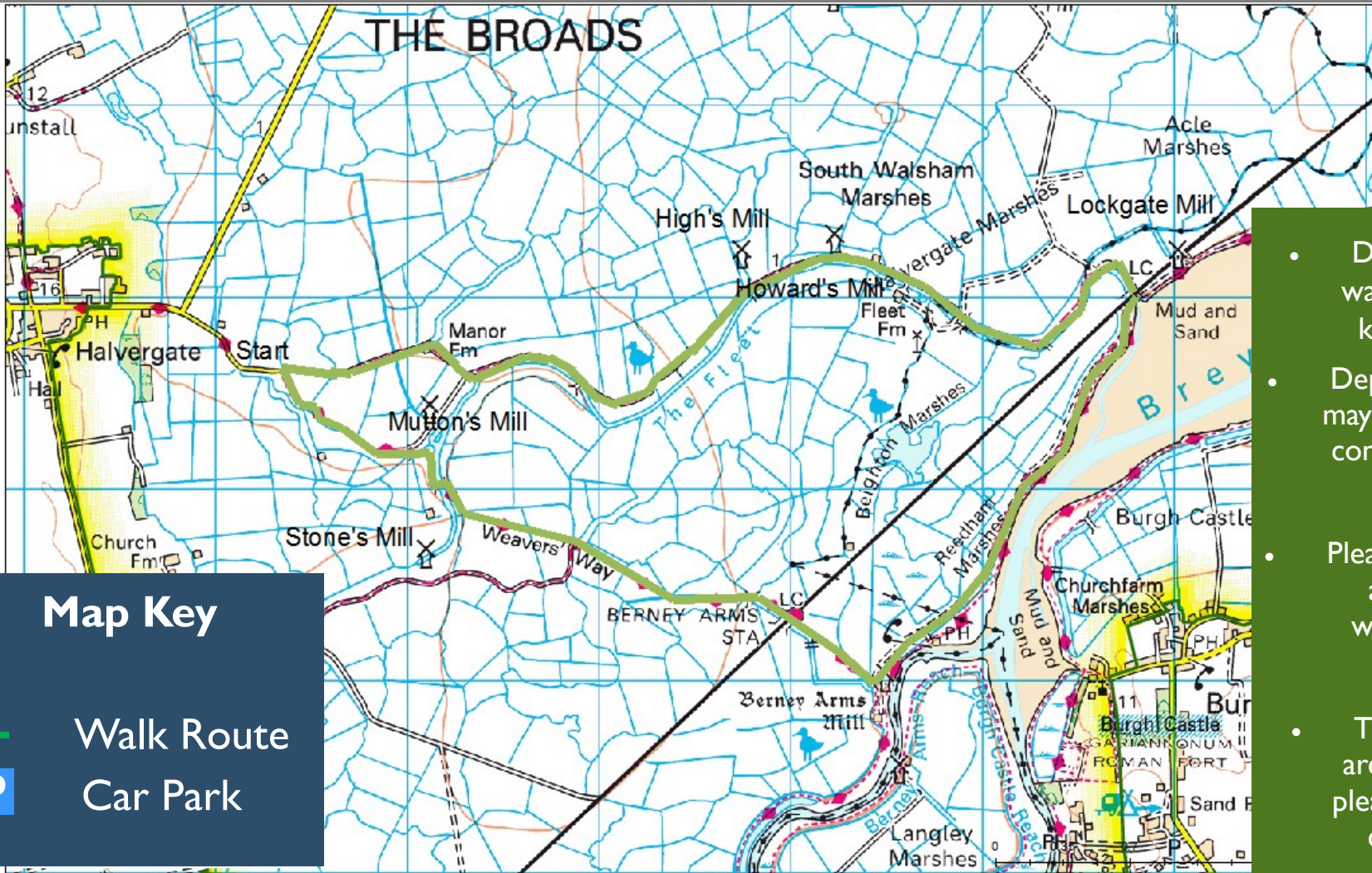
